- The organization is pursuing activities directly related to the foundation's three areas of focused giving
- The organization can provide a clear understanding of desired outcomes and measurements with facts or details about how it will provide a high impact and sustainable benefit
- Must be classified as a 501(c)(3)

VITAL LIFE FOUNDATION WILL NOT PROVIDE FUNDING FOR:

- Religious organizations, unless the program or project they support is classified as a nonprofit 501(c)(3)
- · Organizations that discriminate against individuals based on race, religion, ethnicity or sexual orientation
- · Political Organizations and campaigns

REQUESTS FOR GRANTS SHOULD INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- I. Contact information
- 2. A brief description of the organization's mission and purpose
- 3. A summary of the project and how it relates to the Vital Life Foundation Mission to support healthy aging solutions and or the management of chronic diseases in post-acute or long term living settings
- 4. A description of who will be served by your program or project
- 5. The specific goals, objectives, strategies and tactics of the program or project
- 6. Amount requested
- 7. Proposed budget for the project
- 8. How results will be measured
- 9. A copy of your 501(c)(3) letter
- 10. A list of your current Board of Directors and business affiliations
